The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 252 dated 08.12.2014 registered under Sections 283, 337, 338, 304 (II) IPC, Section 181 M.V. Act at Police Station Mullana, District Ambala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that originally the FIR was registered under Sections 283, 337, 304 A IPC later on it was converted under Section 304(II) IPC. He urges that the allegations are that the truck was parked on the road and a car came from behind and hit into the stationary truck leading to the accident. He urges that the accident took place during day at 3.15 p.m. and the truck was not parked on the road and the petitioner is in custody for the last 8 months and investigations are over and charge has been framed. He also states that revision has been filed against framing of charge and the matter is now pending in the High Court.

The petitioner is in custody for the last 8 months. Initially the FIR was registered under Section 304A IPC which later on converted into Section 304(II) IPC. The accident took place during

day time and the car came from behind and hit the truck which was parked allegedly parked on the road.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and considering the fact that trial is taking time, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing adequate bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
