SABINA, J

Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.31 dated 01.06.2015, under Sections 295, 323, 354, 341, 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 3/ 4 the Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, registered at Police Station Tarsikka, District Amritsar.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 16.07.2015:-

“There are no specific allegations though the complainant may have tried to cover the case under clause (iii) of sub-section 1 of Section 3 of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989.

Notice of motion to the respondent be issued for 11.09.2015.

In the meantime, the arrest of the petitioners shall remain stayed subject to the following conditions:

(i) They shall make themselves available for investigation as and when required to do so.

(ii) They will not leave the country without the prior permission of the Court.

(iii) They will not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police official."

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Assistant Sub Inspector Surinder Singh has submitted that petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for further investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted to the petitioners by this Court vide order dated 16.07.2015, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
