JASWANT SINGH, J (ORAL)

Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.PC to the petitioner-Sukhpreet Kaur in case FIR No.95 dated 04.04.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Patti, District Tarn Taran.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* submits that there is no allegation in the FIR that the petitioner pretending herself to be Tehsildar of Mansa and to project herself to be close relative of Ram Kumar. Petitioner is not the beneficiary of the alleged sale deeds nor has signed the sale deeds in any capacity, nor had any knowledge about the same. No recovery is to be effect from the petitioner in the context of

execution of four sale deeds in favour of Ajaypal, Balbir Kaur and Ranjit Singh.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the interim directions passed by this Court petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from HC Guravtar Singh submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation, nothing is to be recovered from her and as such is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, interim protection/bail granted vide order dated 08.07.2015 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
