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ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.

Affidavit dated 8.7.2015 of Pardeep Kumar-petitioner No. 2 along with marriage certificate dated 5.7.2015 has been filed in the Court and the same are taken on record.

Amrit Kaur and Pardeep Kumar, the petitioners before me, claim themselves to be major. They have pleaded that they have married against the wishes of respondents No. 6 to 13 and seek protection to their life and liberty. They apprehend danger from respondents No. 6 to 13. They have placed on record the marriage certificate and photographs of marriage (Annexure P-3). The petitioners have submitted a representation dated 5.7.2015 (Annexure P-4) to respondent No. 4 along with the copy to respondent No.2.

Without entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the documents placed on the file, I dispose of the petition with directions to respondent No. 2 to decide the representation of the petitioners (Annexure P-4) within a period of one month and grant them protection, if any threat to their life and liberty is perceived. It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by them.
