JASWANT SINGH, J (ORAL)

Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.PC to the petitioners namely Balvir Singh and Harjinder Kaur in case FIR No.253 dated 17.12.2014 for offences punishable under Sections 326, 323 & 34 of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Bhikhiwind, District Tarn Taran.

As per allegations, the petitioner no1. Balvir Singh was armed with *Dang* and petitioner no.2 Harjinder Kaur was empty handed. The role attributed to petitioner no.1 Balvir Singh was that he gave a *Dang* blow on the waist of the complainant whereas complainant Harjinder Kaur is alleged to have dragged the complainant from his hair.

It is contended that the injury that has attracted offence under

Section 326 IPC has been attributed to one Jhirmal Singh.

Learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Bachitter Singh submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner no.1 Balvir Singh has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

As regards petitioner no.2-Harjinder Kaur it is apparent that she is stated to be empty handed.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted vide order dated 08th of July, 2015 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
