SABINA, J

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.39 dated 29.03.2000, under Sections 379, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Kharar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that vide order Annexure P-3, similarly placed co-accused were ordered to the discharged. In fact, petitioner was under the impression that he had also been discharged alongwith his co-accused. Due to this reason, petitioner went to France along with his family. The accused who had faced the trial was acquitted by the trial Court vide order Annexure P-1. Now the petitioner has come to know that he has been declared a proclaimed offender. However, petitioner is ready to surrender before the trial Court.

Accordingly, this petition is disposed of with a direction that in case petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within one month from today, he be released on bail subject to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
