Petitioners-Laddjeet Kaur and her husband-Gurdeep Singh have approached this Court under Section 482 Cr.P.C. praying for direction to official respondent Nos. 1 to 3 to protect their life and liberty and not to interfere in their peaceful married life at the behest of respondent Nos.4 and 5, who are parents of petitioner No.1/girl.

It is stated that the marriage of the petitioners was solemnized on 04.07.2015 at Sanathan Dharam Samita, Sector 4, Panchkula according to Hindu rites and ceremonies with their own consent without any pressure. It is further stated that they are in love since two years. It is further stated that the parents of petitioner No.1/girl wanted her to marry with boy of their consent. It is further submitted that the petitioners have been living outside the skirts of Ludhiana and are living far away from their residence due to the fear from respondent Nos.4 and 5. It is further

submitted that on 04.07.2015, the petitioners made a representation to respondent No.2/S.P., Mansa to protect life and liberty of the petitioners as well as family of petitioner No.2/boy and respondent Nos.4 and 5 does not interfere in the matrimonial life of the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the matter has been settled and wishes to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
