This petition is for seeking protection of life and liberty of petitioners, who alleged to have married against the wishes of respondents No. 4 to 10, parents and relatives of petitioner No.1.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has limited his prayer for taking appropriate action in accordance with law on the representation dated 30.06.2015 (Annexure P-5) made by the petitioners to Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran. It has been stated that both the petitioners are major. The date of birth of petitioner No.1-Rajandeep Kaur is 15.01.1997 as per copy of Birth Certificate (Annexure P-1) and that of petitioner No.2-Ajay Singh is 05.05.1994 as per copy of Driving Licence (Annexure P-2). They allegedly got married on 30.06.2015. Photographs of marriage are Annexure P-4.

In view of the limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioners, but without expressing any opinion on the validity of

marriage of petitioners, this petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Amritsar to look into the representation dated 30.06.2015 Annexure P-5 (addressed to Senior Superintendent of Police, Tam Taran) and take appropriate action in accordance with law, on receipt of certified copy of this order along with representation (Annexure P-5) in his office.

However, it is made clear that this order will have no effect on the validity of alleged marriage of the petitioners or on any other civil or criminal proceedings instituted against them.
