The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 93 dated 07.09.2000 registered at Police Station Mahilpur, District Hoshiarpur under Sections 420/467/468/421/423/471/120-B IPC.

Heard.

The petitioner was declared proclaimed offender in April 2009. He is now seeking anticipatory bail.

Learned counsel for the petitioner urges that the petitioner was declared proclaimed offender and he had gone abroad to take care of his uncle who was suffering from cancer. He further urges that other accused had been acquitted and there was a civil dispute which has also been compromised.

The petitioner has failed to place any document to show that any relative was suffering from cancer or that the petitioner had gone aboard. The petitioner had been granted concession of bail and he had misused the same and has now approached this Court after 5 years. No case for anticipatory bail is made out. The petition

is dismissed.

The petitioner shall surrender before the Court concerned on 20.08.2015. The trial Court would dispose of his application for regular bail as per law.
