This is second petition filed by the petitioner seeking anticipatory bail.

Heard.

The petitioner was allowed anticipatory bail in July 2010 (Annexure P-2). The petitioner has pleaded that after the challan had been presented summons were sent to him and thereafter bailable warrants were issued which were received unserved and the Court below had issued non-bailable warrants of arrest and ultimately he was declared proclaimed offender in 2013.

Learned counsel for the petitioner urges that the compromise has been effected and a separate petition has been filed. The explanation has been given by the petitioner for the absence that he has shifted his residence and refers to the Ration Card (Annexure P-8).

The petitioner has misused the concession allowed to him. He is absent from the Court for about 5 years. The explanation given by him that he has changed his residence appears

to be false on the face of it. Ration Card (Annexure P-8) has been prepared in 2011. The summons, notices and warrants were issued in 2010. There is no ground to give him further any concession.

The petition is dismissed. The petitioner would surrender before the Court concerned on 20.07.2015.
