MAHESH GROVER, J.

Learned counsel for the petitioner after arguing at length prays for permission to withdraw the instant petition with a prayer that the petitioner would submit herself to law and surrenders before the court of competent jurisdiction. He prays that in the eventuality of a prayer for regular bail being made, that should be considered and decided expeditiously.
