Prayer in this petition is for grant of six weeks interim regular bail to the petitioner so as to enable him to check his wife from a specialised medical institution.

The petitioner is facing trial in case FIR No.155 dated 7.8.2013 under Section 8(c) read with Section 15 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short, the NDPS Act) and 468/471 IPC, registered at Police Station, Kalanwali, District Sirsa.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Atma Ram, submits that apart from the fact that the petitioner was declared proclaimed offender in this case, he was also facing trial in two other cases under the

NDPS Act. However, in one case, he was acquitted and in another case, he was discharged. Learned State counsel also draws the attention of this Court towards medical record of the wife of the petitioner, namely, Karamjit Kaur. The said medical record reveals as under:

“COURSE OF TREATMENT IN HOSPITAL:

Patient was admitted with complaints of abdominal pain, nausea & vomitings since few days. CECT Abdomen was done which revealed:

- 1. CHOLELITHIASIS WITH CHRONIC CHOLECTSTITIS.*
- 2. DILATED PORTO-SPLENIC AXIS WITH SPLENOMEGALY, MILD ASCITES & PORTO-SYSTEMIC COLLATERALS S/O PHTN.*
- 3. PORTAL VEIN WALL CALCIFICATIONS & PERIPORTAL COLLATERALS? CHRONIC PARTIAL VEIN THROMBOSIS WITH DILATED BILIARY SYSTEM. MAY BE PORTAL BILIOPATHY OR NCPF.*
- 4. RIGHT OVARIAN/PAROVARIAN SIMPLECYST.*

Patient was managed conservatively with antibiotics, antacids, antiemetics, Inj. HEPAMERJ & IV fluids. Patient is now stable & discharged in satisfactory condition.”

In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, no case for grant of interim regular bail is made out.

Dismissed.
