According to learned State counsel, accused namely Gurdeep Singh who cause injury with the sharp-edged weapon has been arrested.

In the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., petitioner is seeking pre-arrest bail in a case registered against him vide FIR No.61 dated 23.04.2015 under Sections 308/323/324/341/148 and 149 IPC and Section 325 (added later on) at Police Station Sadar, Khanna, Police District Khanna, District Ludhiana.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Avtar Singh submits that pursuant to order dated August 07, 2015, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the interim order dated August 07, 2015, is hereby made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed in aforesaid terms.
