This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking pre-arrest bail to petitioners in a case registered against them vide FIR No.57 dated 26.05.2015 under Sections 323, 324, 452, 148 and 149 IPC at Police Station Amloh, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that pursuant to order dated December 05, 2015, costs have been deposited.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Jaswinder Singh submits that pursuant to order dated July 31, 2015, the petitioners have joined the investigation and are no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the interim order dated July 31, 2015, is hereby made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
