Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, for quashing of the FIR No.43, dated 03.04.2014, under Sections 457 and 380 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station City Moga, District Moga, on the basis of compromise dated 24.04.2014 (Annexure P-2).

Report of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Moga, has been received. The learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Moga has recorded the statement of the complainant as well the accused and reported to this Court that the parties have entered into a compromise of their free will and consent.

There are allegations of theft in the FIR.

Since the matter has been settled between the parties, therefore, the FIR in question along with consequential proceedings stand quashed.

Petition is accordingly allowed.
