Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of direction to the respondents to take appropriate action against respondents no.5 and 6 in FIR No.166 dated 22.09.2013, registered at Police Station Sujanpur, District Gurdaspur, now Pathankot, under Section 306 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned State counsel after seeking instructions from Head Constable Surender Singh submits that cancellation report was presented before the Court of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Pathankot, who has

ordered return of the cancellation report to the concerned SHO for re-investigation from the higher official of the rank of Superintendent of Police, vide order dated 04.05.2015. Copy of the order dated 04.05.2015 is taken on record.
