Petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No.327 dated 27.08.2013, under Section 31 of the Prevention of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 registered at Police Station City Dadri, District Bhiwani on the basis of compromise.

The said FIR was registered at the instance of respondent No.2 Ritu alleging that the petitioner had harassed her and treated her with cruelty besides violating restraint order passed by the Court.

Parties were directed to appear before the trial Court to get their statements recorded. After recording the statements of the parties, a report has been received to the effect that the matter has been compromised and the parties have decided to part company by obtaining divorce under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act.

In view of said circumstances and following the full Bench judgment of this Court in ***Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and others 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052***, the petition is allowed. The aforesaid FIR and all the criminal proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise.
