Mr. R.S. Mamli, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondents No.4 to 6.

File received from Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court with the report that the parties had meeting in a cordial manner.

Learned counsel for respondents No.4 to 6 submits that the respondents No.4 to 6 have no objection to the marriage of the petitioners and undertake not to interfere in their life and liberty.

This petition is for seeking protection of life and liberty of petitioners, who alleged to have married against the wishes of respondents No.4 to 6, parents and brother of petitioner No.1.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has limited his prayer for taking appropriate action in accordance with law on the representation dated 6.7.2015 (Annexure P-5) made by the petitioners. It has been stated that both the petitioners are major. The date of birth of petitioner No.1- is 2.7.1997 as per copy of Adhar Card (Annexure P-1) and that of petitioner No.2- is 24.9.1988 as per copy of Adhar Card (Annexure P-2). They allegedly got married on 6.7.2015. Photographs of marriage are Annexure P-3.

In view of the limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioners, but without expressing any opinion on the validity of

marriage of petitioners, this petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Kaithal to look into the representation dated 6.7.2015 (Annexure P-5) and take appropriate action in accordance with law, on receipt of certified copy of this order along with representation in his office.

However, it is made clear that this order will have no effect on the validity of alleged marriage of the petitioners or on any other civil or criminal proceedings instituted against them.
