Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.806 dated 02.09.2014, under Sections 420, 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Chandni Bagh, Panipat.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 10.07.2015:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the allegations in the FIR pertains to agreement to sell which was executed in the year 2008.

Notice of motion for 7.8.2015.

In the meantime, the arrest of the petitioners shall remain stayed subject to the following conditions:-

i) They will make themselves available for investigation as and when required to do so.

ii) They will not leave the country without the prior permission of the Court.

iii) They will not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police official."

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Sub Inspector Dalbir Singh and the learned counsel for the complainant have submitted that the petitioners have joined investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted to the petitioners by this Court vide order dated 10.07.2015, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
