A criminal complaint under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code was filed against the present three petitioners by the respondent/Amarjit Kaur. On evaluation of pre-summoning the evidence, the complaint was dismissed by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Jalandhar, vide order dated 17.04.2014 (**Annexure P-4**).

On a revision filed by the complainant/respondent before the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Jalandhar, the same was allowed, vide order dated 07.10.2014 (**Annexure P-1**) and the matter was referred back to learned Magistrate for considering the matter afresh regarding summoning of the accused. Thereafter, on reconsideration, learned trial Court has issued summoning order dated 23.12.2014 (**Annexure P-3**). Hence, the present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of the revisional order dated 07.10.2014 (**P-1**) and the summoning order dated 23.12.2014 (**P-3**), passed by learned JMJC, Jalandhar.

It cannot be disputed that the summoning order is revisable and the order (**P-1**) stood implemented by issuance of the summoning order by filing of

the present petition. Be that as it may, learned Counsel for the petitioners seeks permission to withdraw the present petition in the light of the parties having amicably settled and having withdrawn the complaint itself.

In view of the above, the present petition stands dismissed as withdrawn.
