Kuldip Singh, J. (Oral)

It is stated that Jaswinder Kaur has been examined before the trial Court. It is a case of version and cross-version. The petitioners were arrested on 6.1.2014 and now one year has elapsed. The case is still to be decided on merits.

Learned counsel for the complainant has not opposed the bail application.

Since the crucial witness has been examined, further detention of the petitioners is considered to be unnecessary and therefore, they are ordered to be released on bail on their furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹.50,000/- each with one surety in the like amount, to the satisfaction of the Trial Court, Amritsar, subject to

the following conditions:-

- i) the petitioner will not directly or indirectly give any inducement, threat or promise to any witness acquainted with the facts of the case;
- ii) the petitioner will not commit any offence while on bail;
- iii) the petitioner will not leave the country without the prior permission of the trial Court.
- iv) the petitioner will appear before the trial Court on each and every date.
