The present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of concession of regular bail to the petitioner in case First Information Report No. 23 dated 24.04.2015 under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468 and 471 of the Indian Penal Code and under Section 25/54/59 of Arms Act registered at Police Station Rajpura, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the parties have been heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that one co-accused of the petitioner namely Vishvajeet @ Vishva was enlarged on regular bail by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Patiala vide order dated 01.06.2015 and the other co-accused namely Parmod Kumar was allowed regular bail by this Court vide order dated 14.07.2015. Submitting that the petitioner is in custody since 24.04.2015, learned counsel prays that

he be also enlarged on regular bail.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the ground of parity and the fact that trial would not be concluded in the near future, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is released on bail subject to his furnishing bail/surety bonds, to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Patiala.
