Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 ('Cr. P.C.' for short) seeking quashing of orders dated 27.04.2010 (Annexure P-1) and dated 22.01.2014 (Annexure P-3).

Heard.

Order dated 27.04.2010 (Annexure P-1) reads as under:

"27.04.2010

Today this Kalendra under Section 107 (150 Cr. P.C. was presented by Police Station Rampura. Respondent No.1 to 28 of the first party and respondents No.1 to 4 of the second party be summoned through summons and the file be produced on 17.05.2010."

Petitioners had challenged the above said order dated 27.04.2010 by way of revision and the Court of revision dismissed the revision petition vide order dated 22.01.2014 (Annexure P-3). As per the Section 116 (6) Cr. P.C., inquiry ordered for security for keeping the peace is to be completed within a period of six months from the date of its commencement and if it is not so completed, proceedings shall stand terminated unless for special reasons to be recorded in writing, the Magistrate directs otherwise.

Thus, in the present case, after expiry of six months of passing of the order Annexure P-1, the proceedings stood terminated as no order had been passed by the Magistrate directing otherwise. The Court of revision should have disposed of the revision petition as having been rendered infructuous.

Accordingly, the impugned order dated 22.01.2014 (Annexure P-3) is set aside and it is ordered that the revision petition filed by the petitioners had been rendered infructuous.

Petition stands disposed of, accordingly.
