MAHESH GROVER, J.

The instant petition is totally misconceived. The court would not in the exercise of its jurisdiction under Section 482 Cr.P.C. restrain any person from entering or direct a person not to stay in a particular house as is the case made out by the petitioner. However, in case the petitioner is wanted by the police in connection with any investigation or offence, they would ensure compliance of the provisions of Section 160 Cr.P.C.
