is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, Bawa Singh, who

FIR No.82, dated 25.05.2015, registered at Police Station, Kurali,

District SAS Nagar.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the State, on instructions from HC Kaser Singh, Police Station, Kurali, District SAS Nagar, submits that the petitioner did join the investigation and no more required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, interim directions issued vide order dated 10.07.2015 are made absolute. He shall continue to join the investigation as and when required to do so and abide by all the conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
