Report dated 05.10.2015 sent by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Hoshiarpur has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Gurdev Singh, Mohinder Singh, Sonu, Mandeep and Manjit Singh as well as of complainant Jagjit Singh @ Jagga it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view the nature of offence and that the parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.98 dated 14.6.2012 under

Sections 148,323,324,326,149 IPC, Police Station, Bullowal, District Hoshiarpur and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioners.
