INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner Kamaljit Singh alias Kamal has preferred this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.151 dated 21.09.2014, registered at Police Station Division No.3, Jalandhar, District Jalandhar, under Sections 307, 326, 341, 148, 149, 506 IPC.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record.

The petitioner is named in the FIR. He is stated to be armed with sword. 'Lalkara' is also attributed to him. As per FIR, though no injury has been attributed to the petitioner but as per the allegations in the FIR, after the blow inflicted with 'dattar' by co-accused Puneet, the hand of complainant was cut and it started hanging. Since the sword is to be recovered, therefore, the petitioner is required for custodial interrogation.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and gravity of the offence, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Accordingly, the instant petition stands dismissed.
