MAHESH GROVER, J.

This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking direction to respondent No.1 to take appropriate action against the private respondents for tampering with the revenue record thereby causing huge loss to the administration and exchequer.

On a prior occasion, this Court had given directions to the senior functionaries of the police to look into the grievance of the petitioner and decide his representation. There is also some material on record to indicate that the petitioner was contacted and he stated that he does not wish to pursue the matter. This, however, is seriously contested by the learned counsel for the petitioner to contend that no such statement was ever made by the petitioner on telephone.

Be that as it may, the question remains that the petitioner

alleges serious irregularities committed by some officers/persons which has caused loss to the exchequer. In the considered view of this Court the petitioner has a remedy of approaching the Magistrate under Section 156(3) Cr.P.C. and file a complaint.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
