Petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. 23.04.2015 in a case of raid conducted pursuant to the complaint of Sri Bhagwan alleging that the petitioner demanded and received a sum of Rs.2200/- from the complainant as gratification in a case regarding his dispute with Paramjit Singh. The petitioner had allegedly demanded and received the money after the matter has been compromised.

Since the recovery has already been effected and after presentation of challan, six witnesses having already examined, the petitioner can be granted the concession of bail. It is ordered that the petitioner will be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court subject to the condition that the petitioner will not in any manner threaten the witnesses or make any attempt to tamper with the evidence.

In case of any such eventuality, it will be open to the complainant or the prosecution agency to seek cancellation of the bail.
