Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of direction to the respondents to conduct fair and impartial investigation in accordance with law in case FIR No.103 dated 02.05.2015, registered at Police Station Nakodar, District Jalandhar, under Sections 420, 328 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the record.

The FIR has been registered on 02.05.2015 and investigation is being conducted under the supervision of Deputy

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Superintendent of Police (Rural), Jalandhar. No special grounds have been mentioned on the basis of which investigation should be transferred to any other officer.

Dismissed.

However, in order to safeguard the interest of petitioner, respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police (Rural), Jalandhar is directed to supervise and monitor the investigation of case.
