This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure preferred by Sudhir Kumar seeking direction to the official respondents for protecting the life and liberty of the petitioner as well as his family members at the hands of respondent No.4.

Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 3 only, at this stage.

At the asking of the Court, Ms. Priyanka Sadar, AAG, Punjab has accepted notice on behalf of the respondents-State. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel, during the course of the day.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that though the matter was earlier enquired by DSP who has submitted his report (Annexure P-12) observing that the dispute between the parties is with regard to financial transactions and the complainant has been advised to pursue the matter before the concerned Court but despite that fact SSP, Fazilka is calling the petitioner time and again simply on the ground that a fresh inquiry is being conducted into the allegations levelled against him. Though representation (Annexure P-13) was moved to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka on July 2, 2015 but till date no action has been taken. Learned counsel for the petitioner feels

satisfied, in case, direction is issued to Superintendent of Police, Fazilka to

enquire into the averments made in Annexure P-12 and to proceed in accordance with law.

Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with direction to Superintendent of Police, Fazilka to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation (Annexure P-12) and in case, some substance is found, take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
