The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and personal liberty by raising an apprehension to the same at the hands of private respondents on account of having entered into matrimony against the wishes of the elders.

While issuing notice of motion on 21.01.2015, liberty was granted to the petitioners to approach respondent No.2 i.e. Superintendent of Police, Sonipat, for protection, in the light of instructions dated 21.02.2011 issued by the Home Department, Haryana.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Naresh Kumar would apprise the Court that the petitioners, in spite of the liberty having been granted, have not approached respondent No.2 for protection.

It appears to the Court that the petitioners are now not in need of any protection on account of their marriage and perhaps that also explains the non-appearance of the counsel for the petitioners today as well as on the last date of hearing i.e. 11.05.2015.

No directions are required to be passed.

Petition dismissed.
