ANITA CHAUDHRY, J(ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.69 dated 11.08.2014, registered under Sections 109, 316, 120-B, 304-B IPC, Police Station Jalandhar Cantt., District Jalandhar.

Both the sides have been heard.

A suicide note was left by the deceased and the complaint was lodged by the brother. The mother and son were challaned. The Magistrate had summoned the father-in-law under Section 193 Cr.P.C.

The complainant side has opposed the bail application and has urged that when the matter came up for hearing in the Court, the petitioner's husband had attacked the complainant and he is influential and is a councillor and the police who is under pressure, did not register any case and had initiated proceedings under Section 107, 151 Cr.P.C. and the complainant side are under a constant threat.

The deceased had left behind a suicide note which clearly brings out the agony she was undergoing. Tempers are high. The police had registered case under Section 107, 151 Cr.P.C. against both the sides. I am not inclined to grant bail at this stage.

Faced with this, the petitioner prays for interim bail for a week on the plea that petitioner's father had died on 05.05.2015. He has placed on record copy of the death certificate. It is stated that the Kirya ceremony has to take place on 18.05.2015.

In view of the above circumstances, interim bail is allowed to the petitioner from 16.05.2015 up till 20.05.2015 to enable her to attend the last rites/kirya of her father, on furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court. The petitioner would surrender before the trial Court on 21.05.2015.
