By filing the present second petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No.53, dated 24.06.2014, registered under Sections 307, 323, 324, 326, 341, 506, 148, 149 IPC, at Police Station Dugri Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

The earlier bail petition filed by the petitioner was dismissed on 26.02.2015. The FIR in the instant case was registered on 24.06.2014. Despite the fact that more than a year has gone by, the petitioner is evading the process of the Court. Now, the present

petition has been filed in the garb of statement made by the complainant who in the FIR alleged specific role to the petitioner but the assertion in the affidavit is contrary to the statement, therefore, the same cannot be said to be a circumstance in favour of the petitioner. The petitioner has successfully evaded the process of the Court, therefore, he does not deserve the concession of bail.

Dismissed.
