The instant petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for issuance of direction to respondent No.3 not to harass and humiliate the petitioners.

It is submitted on behalf of the petitioners that they are being called time and again by the police and are made to sit in the police station for long hours without disclosing any reason. So far no criminal case is registered against them.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and without commenting on merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the police that in case, the petitioners are required to be summoned for any enquiry, a notice under Section 160 Cr.P.C. be given to them.
