Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Raminder Pal Singh in case FIR No.1 dated 12.02.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 7/8/13 of the Prevention of Corruption Act registered with Police Station Vigilance Bureau, Phase-1, SAS Nagar, Mohali, Punjab.

As per allegations levelled by the Vigilance Bureau, Punjab the petitioner was an active conduit of one co-accused Inspector Inderjit Singh who was working as Incharge CIA. There are specific allegations that the petitioner collected a huge amount of Rs.13.50 lacs from one Jagdeep Singh and Parminder Singh.

Counsel for the parties have been heard.

Learned State Counsel on instructions from Inspector Charles, PS Vigilance Bureau, Phase-1, SAS Nagar, Mohali, Punjab states that although the petitioner has joined investigation but he is not co-operating with the investigating agency.

Keeping in view the specific allegations, the nature and gravity of offence, it is apparent that to complete the chain of investigation custodial interrogation of the petitioner is required, as such the petitioner is not entitled to the concession of anticipatory bail.
