Petitioner, by way of instant petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure ('Cr.P.C.' for short) read with Section 340 Cr.P.C., seeks direction to respondents No.1 & 2 to take legal action against respondent No.3 because he has allegedly misled this Court by making a factually wrong averment in para 14 of his petition bearing CRM-M-19394-2015 that both were unmarried before solemnization of their marriage.

After arguing the case for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission of the Court to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to avail his other remedies, in accordance with law.

Permission is granted.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty, as prayed for.
