This petition has been moved by the petitioner under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail in case FIR No. 03 dated 08.01.2015, under Section 304-B of the Indian Penal Code of Police Station Ghuman, District Gurdaspur.

The petitioner is in custody since 09.01.2015. Charge-sheet stands presented in Court, but charges have yet not been drawn up.

The petitioner is the father-in-law of Gurpreet Kaur, who was married to Sarabjit Singh son of the petitioner, and there are allegations in the FIR that the husband, father-in-law and sisters-in-law of Gurpreet Kaur harassed her on account of dowry. All the accused are stated to be in custody.

Since trial is yet to start and will take a long time to conclude, it is felt that the petitioner is entitled to bail.

In view of the above, the request of the petitioner for bail is

allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
