The present petition has been filed for grant of the anticipatory bail by the petitioner Manoj Kumar in case FIR No. 75 dated 08.08.2011, under Sections 379, 328, 34 of Indian Penal Code (Sections 148, 149 IPC added lateron), registered at Police Station Sohana, District SAS Nagar, Mohali.

Learned counsel for the petitioner pleaded that on 03.06.2015, the petitioner could not appear before the trial Court as he was lying admitted at Civil Hospital, Ropar. The documents to this effect has been placed on record. He further pleaded that on 03.06.2015 itself an application was moved before the trial Court for seeking exemption of the personal appearance of the petitioner, but by that time warrants were already issued.

In these circumstances, the present petition is hereby

disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to appear before the learned trial Court and to seek the remedy of the regular bail in-accordance with law. If, the petitioner appears before the trial Court within ten days from today, his application shall be disposed of by the learned trial Court on the same day taking into consideration the reasons pleaded by the petitioner for his absence on the date fixed.
