This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.224 dated 04.06.2015 registered under Sections 61, 1, 14 of the Excise Act, at Police Station A Division, District Amritsar City.

After arguing for some time, the learned counsel for the petitioners states that he does not wish to press this petition on merits but liberty may be granted to the petitioners to surrender before the Court and move an application for regular bail and the Court may be directed to decide the said application expeditiously.

I find this to be a fair request. Let the petitioners surrender

before the Court within a week and move an application for regular bail which shall be decided expeditiously by the Court but in any case within 3 days on merits. It is made clear that in case the petitioners do not surrender before the Court in the aforesaid manner the present petition would be deemed to have been dismissed.

Petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
