This petition has been filed for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.25 dated 21.01.2012 registered at Police Station Sohna, District Gurgaon for offences punishable under Section 4A/8/2/80 of the Punjab Cow Slaughter Act; 11 of Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act, 1960, 307 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was in custody in some other case. He was declared proclaimed offender in May, 2013. Thereafter he is in custody in this case since 21.11.2014.

Learned State counsel submits that the petitioner had earlier absconded and he was also involved in other case where he has been convicted and sentenced. In this case the prosecution has already examined ten witnesses out of 15 witnesses.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner was earlier on bail in this case and now he is in custody in this case for the last about eight months, but without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner-Jafu is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Gurgaon subject to following terms:-

1. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
2. In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh before the trial Court.
3. He shall not leave the country without previous permission of the Court.
