Instant petition has been moved under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure by Rajinder Kaur, seeking pre-arrest bail, feeling apprehension of her arrest, in case FIR No. 81, dated 17.03.2015, under Section 420, 406 and 120-B IPC, Police Station City, District Tarn Taran.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by a coordinate Bench of this Court on July 14, 2015:-

“Petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in FIR No. 81 dated 17.3.2015 under Sections 420/406/120-B IPC registered at Police Station City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that

no allegation was levelled by the complainant against the petitioner in the FIR. He further submits that husband of the petitioner was employed with the travel agency and the petitioner has nothing to do with it.

Notice to the Advocate General, Punjab, for 21.8.2015.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of arresting/investigating officer subject to the conditions provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. The petitioner is also directed to join and cooperate with the investigating agency, as and when required.”

On instructions, from ASI Tarsem Singh, learned State counsel has submitted that in compliance of order dated August 21, 2015, petitioner has joined the investigation on August 24, 2015 and has cooperated with the investigating agency. She is no more required for further investigation/interrogation. Moreover, main allegations are against the husband of petitioner.

Taking into consideration the above facts of the case, interim order dated July 14, 2015, is made absolute, subject to the conditions, as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
