Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.PC to the petitioner Risham Mehra @ Rishu in case FIR No.141 dated 25.12.2011 for offences punishable under Sections 382, 353, 186, 332, 506, 148 and 149 of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station C Division, District Amritsar.

As per allegations in the FIR lodged by Lakhwinder Singh- Punjab Home Guard, he was beaten up by 3-4 persons and money out of his wallet was taken away.

It is contended that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in a four years old case in which no investigation was ever made.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the

interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Davinder Singh submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted vide order dated 10th of September, 2015 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
