Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal complaint No.14682 dated 28.2.2013 titled as 'Ranjit Singh Vs. Gurdeep Singh and another', under Sections 420, 465, 467 and 468 read with Section 120-B IPC, pending before the Court of Judicial Magistrate 1<sup>st</sup> Class, Jalandhar.

In the aforesaid complaint, the petitioner has been summoned on the allegation of misuse of cheque which was signed by the complainant. In the said proceedings, the petitioner was issuedailable warrants.

At this stage, Mr.Rajiv Joshi, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the complainant and has contended that not only the process of law has been abused rather there are serious allegations against the petitioner.

Considering the fact that present case is a criminal complaint and the trial is in the initial stage, the order dated July 15, 2015 is made absolute. The trial court is directed to admit the petitioner on bail subject to his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction its satisfaction. Trial court is further directed to expedite the trial.

Petition is disposed of.
