Report dated 5.8.2015 sent by learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Amritsar has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Arshdeep Singh, Gagandeep Singh, Mandeep Singh, Japneet Singh, Rahul, Mohinder Singh, Ranbir Singh @ Rana as well as of complainant Vikas Kumar it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and to bring about harmonious atmosphere and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.102 dated

13.6.2015 under Sections 307,148,149 IPC and read with Sections 25,27,54,59 of Arms Act, Police Station, Sadar Amritsar and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.

Petition stands disposed off.
