The instant petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for issuance of direction to respondent No.3 not to harass and humiliate the petitioner at the hands of respondent no.4.

It is submitted on behalf of the petitioner that he is being called time and again by the police and is made to sit in the police station for long hours without disclosing any reason. So far no criminal case is registered against him. Complaint made by respondent No.4 was enquired into twice by the competent authority and the petitioner was found innocent.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and without commenting on merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the police that in case, the petitioner is required to be summoned for any enquiry, a notice under Section 160 Cr.P.C. be given to him.
