Petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No.242 dated 28.10.2011 under Sections 307, 34 IPC registered at Police Station Focal Point Ludhiana.

Complainant Hardip Singh got registered the FIR on the allegations that on 26.10.2011, it was Diwali holiday. At about 9.30 PM, he along with injured Manpreet Singh and Makhan Singh was standing in front of Medical store. In the meanwhile, offending vehicle being driven by the petitioner came in a rash and negligent manner from the side of bus stand and hit against them with an intention to kill. Raghvir Singh was also sitting in the car. Complainant further alleged that there was a conflict between them and the petitioner in which Panchayat got the matter compromised, but the petitioner was keeping grudge in his mind. Accident was claimed to be result of such grievance kept by the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner pointed out that in

MLR dated 26.10.2011, alleged occurrence has been shown as road accident. FIR came to be registered after two days of hospitalization of injured. Injured remained conscious and well oriented throughout. Occurrence took place on 26.10.2011 and the matter remained pending at different levels and ultimately petitioner has been arrested on 01.06.2015.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Tarsem Singh seeks to explain delay on the ground that matter was investigated at different levels and now challan is yet to be presented.

At this stage, without adverting anything on the merits and keeping in view the date of occurrence and other prima facie circumstances, petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ludhiana.

Nothing expressed hereinabove would be construed to be an expression of any opinion on merits of the case.
