RAMESHWAR SINGH MALIK, J. (Oral)

Petitioner seeks appropriate direction to the respondent-police authorities for providing protection to life and liberty of the petitioner who was being harassed by respondent No.4, at the instance of respondent No.5.

Notice of motion was issued and pursuant thereto, reply on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 4 has been filed. A separate reply was filed on behalf of respondent No.5.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from HC Bhupinder Singh, Police Station Division No.5, Ludhiana, submits that representation moved by the petitioner was received and it was enquired into. Allegations levelled by the petitioner were found baseless. Matter was found pertaining to a rent note. Accordingly, the representation filed by the petitioner was disposed of. He further submits that in this view of the matter, present petition does not survive and the same may be disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous.

Although, the above-said statement made by the learned counsel for the State seems to be justified and has also gone unrebutted because nobody has come present on behalf of the petitioner, yet in the interest of justice, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana-respondent No.2 to ensure that no harm is caused to the life and liberty of the petitioner, at the hands of respondent No.5 or anybody else on his behalf.

Disposed of, accordingly.
