AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

On 16.07.2015 the following order was passed :-

"Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.54 dated 14.05.2014, registered at Police Station Bullawal, under Sections 148/307/326/325/324/323/149 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been summoned under Section 319 of the Code of Criminal Procedure as additional accused and he is ready and willing to appear before the trial Court and furnish bail bonds and join the process of law.

Notice of motion for 24.08.2015.

Meanwhile, petitioner may appear before the trial Court and submit bail bonds. On doing so, petitioner is directed to be released

on interim bail to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate."

Learned Additional Advocate General on instructions has stated that pursuant to the interim order dated 16.07.2015 the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the facts and circumstances of the case, without going into the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Resultantly, the petition is allowed. The interim order dated 16.07.2015 is made absolute.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
