Report dated 5.8.2015 sent by learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ambala has been received, whereby, after recording statement of petitioner Jaspal Singh as well as of complainant Ritu Singh Mann it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and to bring about harmonious atmosphere and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.350 dated 20.9.2014 under Section 354 IPC, Police Station, Ambala City and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
